



Anti-Trust Compliance Policy

Maine Vaccine Board

Maine Vaccine Board (the “MVB”) has been established by act of the Maine Legislature for the purpose of collecting and remitting adequate funds from health carriers and third party administrators for the cost of vaccines provided to certain children of the state of Maine. MVB will comply fully with all laws that relate to the conduct of its activities, including all antitrust laws.

MVB Board is comprised, among others, of insurers and third party administrators that are participants in the Maine health care coverage marketplace and MVB’s board of directors and officers include representatives of insurers and third party administrators. Participants in MVB activities must limit discussions and any sharing of information to that necessary to the legitimate purposes of the MVB and refrain from any discussion that may suggest that the members of the MVB are agreeing to take any action that would affect prices, services, allocation of markets or other matters having an effect in the marketplace outside bona fide endeavors.

The MVB acts with the guidance of legal counsel. Any Board member who has concerns regarding the propriety of any board activity or discussion, either in a formal meeting or otherwise, is advised to notify legal counsel for the Board, their own legal counsel, or both. Any other participant in MVB activities who has concerns regarding the propriety of any board activities or discussions may notify Board counsel and may consult with their own legal counsel at their own discretion.
