

Anti-Trust Compliance Policy

Washington Vaccine Association

Washington Vaccine Association (the “Association”) has been established by act of the Washington Legislature for the purpose of collecting and remitting adequate funds from health carriers and third party administrators for the cost of vaccines provided to certain children of the state of Washington. The Association will comply fully with all laws that relate to the conduct of its activities, including all antitrust laws.

The Association membership is comprised of insurers and third party administrators that are participants in the Washington health care coverage marketplace and the Association’s board of directors and officers include representatives of insurers and third party administrators. Participants in Association activities must limit discussions and any sharing of information to that necessary to the legitimate purposes of the Association and refrain from any discussion that may suggest that the members of the Association are agreeing to take any action that would affect prices, services, allocation of markets or other matters having an effect in the marketplace outside the Association’s bona fide endeavors.

The Association acts with the guidance of legal counsel. Any participant in activities of the Association having a concern as to the propriety of an activity or discussion, either in a formal meeting or otherwise, should notify legal counsel and seek legal advice before continuing.

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
